

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 29A, Article 3 of the West Virginia code of 1931, as amended, I hereby submit three copies of proposed rules and regulations relating to the West Virginia Personal Income Tax. Specifically, these regulations deal with income received by persons 65 and over or persons totally and permanently disabled. Such regulations concern topics not covered by existing rules and regulations.
