

Facts and Circumstances

The West Virginia Board of Veterinary Medicine needs to modify Series 6, Schedule of Fees to cover costs incurred by the Board in having background checks done on CAET candidates, by the WV State Police. We also need a fee for the North America Veterinary Licensure Exam (NAVLE) eligibility. In the past, the national test eligibility has been handled by the testing organization. This eligibility determination responsibility has now been passed on to the states.

Brief Summary

The amendments to Series 6 will set a fee for the CAET candidates to cover the costs of the background checks, and will set a fee for the NAVLE eligibility for veterinary licensure candidates.
