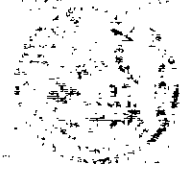

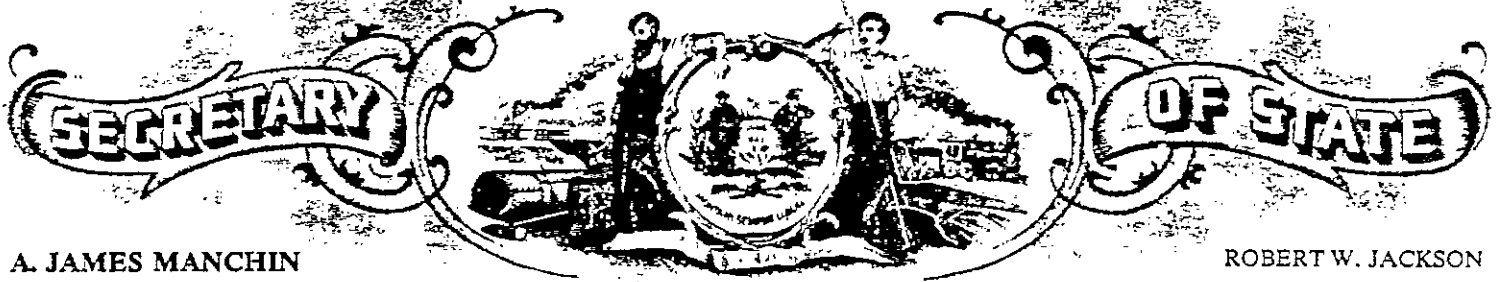

(f) All streams and their tributaries in West Virginia shall be individually identified using an alphanumeric system as identified in the "Key to West Virginia Stream Systems and Major Tributaries" (1956) as published by the Conservation Commission of West Virginia. The water use category for each segment will be assigned as data relative to existing water quality is obtained.

MAJOR RIVER BASINS AND THEIR ALPHANUMERIC SYSTEM

7.11 Potomac River Basin - P, PC, PNB, PSB and S

All streams and their tributaries in West Virginia, draining to the North Branch of the Potomac River, including the South Branch of the Potomac River. All streams and their tributaries in West Virginia draining to the Potomac River from its headwaters at the junction of the North and South Branches of the Potomac to the State line at Harpers Ferry, West Virginia, including the Shenandoah River.

Exceptions:

(a) Except for the unnamed tributary of the South Branch of Buzzard Run below Prather Pond shall not have the use of B1; therefore may contain chlorides not to exceed 250 mg/l.

(b) Except for Turkey Run a small tributary of Opequon Creek (P-4) of the Potomac River shall not have use B1; and therefore may contain fluoride not to exceed 8 mg/l, ammonia not to exceed 4 mg/l, chlorides not to exceed 530 mg/l, cyanide (as free cyanide $\text{HCN} + \text{CN}^-$) not to exceed 50 ug/l and hexavalent chromium (total) not to exceed 100 ug/l.

A BILL to amend and reenact section twenty (five-a)(three), article two, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to authorizing the water resources board to promulgate legislative rules relating to water quality standards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twenty (five-a)(three), article two, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. EXECUTIVE AGENCY AUTHORIZATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-2-20(5a)(3). Water resources board.

(a) The legislative rules filed in the state register on the sixth day of January, one thousand nine hundred eighty-three, relating to the state water resources board

1 (underground injection control program), are authorized.

2 (b) The legislative rules filed in the state register on
3 the fifteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred
4 eighty-three, relating to the state water resources board
5 (special regulations), are authorized.

6 (c) The legislative rules filed in the state register on
7 the third day of August, one thousand nine hundred
8 eighty-three, relating to the state water resources board
9 (groundwater protection standards), are authorized.

10 (d) The legislative rules filed in the state register on
11 the fifteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred
12 eighty-three, relating to the state water resources board
13 (state national pollutant discharge elimination system
14 (NPDES) program), are authorized.

15 (e) The Legislature hereby authorizes and directs the
16 water resources board to promulgate rules relating to water
