Re: Repeal of Legislative Rule, Title 85, Series 8: "Medical Fee Schedule"

Dear Secretary Hechler:

Please consider this letter my written notice that the above noted rule is hereby repealed.
Series 8 will be reserved for future use.

Pursuant to West Virginia Code §23-4-3(a), as amended by the passage of Enrolled Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 250, the Workers' Compensation Division "shall establish and alter from time to time as the division may determine to be appropriate a schedule of the maximum reasonable amounts to be paid ... for the rendering of treatment or services to injured employees under this chapter. The division also ... from time to time, as the division may consider appropriate, shall submit the [medical fee] schedule, with any changes thereto, to the Legislature..."

In accordance with the revised statute, a copy of the current medical fee schedule and related documents have been filed with Speaker of the House, Mr. Robert "Chuck" Chambers, and Senate President, Mr. Earl Ray Tomblin.
