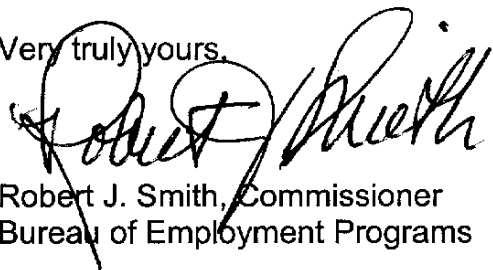
Re: Proposed Rule 85 C.S.R. 15, "Vocational Rehabilitation Provider"
