Please be advised that the Workers' Compensation Division hereby withdraws this proposed rule and will not proceed with its promulgation.

The reason for this action is the enactment of Enrolled Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 250 and its extensive rewrite of West Virginia Code, §23-4-6. The proposed rule needs to be reformulated to meet the new requirements of that statute and the division believes this would best be accomplished by starting the rule making process anew. The division wishes to reserve series number 18 for later use.
