Dear Secretary Tennant:

The West Virginia Board of Education, at its March 14, 2012, meeting voted to repeal, effective upon the effective date (April 16, 2012) of 126CSR41, Policy 2460, Educational Purpose and Acceptable Use of Electronic Resources, Technologies and the Internet, the following rules:

126CSR43, Policy 2470, Use of Technology by Students and Educators, filed December 16, 1996, and effective July 1, 1997; and,

126CSR153, Policy 5711, Copyright Protected Computer Software Print and Non-Print Media, filed December 18, 1992, and effective January 22, 1993.

Furthermore, nothing in the repeal of these rules shall be interpreted by any school system as not having to comply with said rule prior to its repeal.
