MS. COSCO: Well, good evening. My name is Kathy Cosco and I am with the Public Information Office. Welcome to the DEP and the public hearing on three of the Agency's proposed rules.

This evening we will be taking comments on changes to 60CSR3, the Voluntary Remediation and Redevelopment rule; 47CSR5A, Rules for Individual Certification of Activities Requiring a Federal Permit; and 47CSR2, Requirement Governing Water Quality Standards.

To make the most efficient use of our time we will open the hearing for comments on the first rule, and once everyone who wishes to speak about that rule has a chance to do so we will close the hearing on that rule and immediately open the next hearing for the next rule.

We have three sign-in sheets in the back. I have already collected the first round, but if you would like to add your name I'll gather that up. But if you wish to speak about all three rules, we ask that you make sure your name is on each of the sign-in sheets. However, if you only wish to comment on one, your name only needs to be on that sign in sheet.

If nobody has any questions I will begin by opening the hearing for 60CSR3, the Voluntary Remediation rule.

4 The rule was last amended in the 2010 Federal
5 Session. The proposed changes were being considered
6 tonight include updating the list of all profiles used in
7 the development of the De Minimis Rule to bring that into
8 conformance with the Federal Government's rule. The
9 rule is used to determine whether a contaminant
10 contaminant in a site exceeds the level that would be
11 protective of human health.

12 Additionally, the rule defines the definition of
13 the hourly level, the hourly rate, the level, and the
14 application to be applied. These amendments provide
15 clarifying the functions of the De Minimis Registration
16 program as it is continued down to the funding level of
17 Federal Government would grant.
