Andrews	5.2 – The Education of Children in Out-of-Home Care Advisory Committee recommends that a quarterly or bi-annual report would be more beneficial to ensure that children are appropriately placed upon reentry to the public school system. The report should include the name of the student, the placement they are exiting from, and the placement the local school district has selected for providing services to the student. The report should also include a section for the local school district to provide their rationale for the placement selected. This section should also include authority to collect this data for children in the custody of DHHR placed in institutional settings including children returning from out-of-state placements. Policy statements defining the roles and responsibilities of both the department the local school district regarding providing a free and appropriate education for student returning from institutional settings would be appropriate.
