Good Afternoon Jamie,

We are concerned about the first statement in your original email in which you detail Ruby Memorial Hospital may be allowing unlicensed individual to operate fluoroscopy equipment. Is it your intention to report this as a complaint for investigation by the West Virginia Medical Imaging & Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners (Board) Ethics Committee? If so, please respond to this email at your earliest convenience in order for us to transfer this information to an official "Complaint Form" and begin an investigation.

The Board has not considered any changes related to an individual holding the RCIS certification. While this issue was not addressed in the current proposed rule change we will certainly keep this in mind for future consideration.

The proposed change in fee from \$100.00 to \$140.00 applies only to individuals requesting to take the "State Only" examination that is administered for the Board's applicants by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists, (ARRT). The ARRT recently increased their testing fee from \$100.00 to \$140.00 for the State Only examination.

The proposed State Only examination fee increase does not in any way impact the annual renewal of a West Virginia Medical Imaging License, (\$65.00), nor for those individuals applying for an original license, (\$100.00). Both the Original and Renewal Application fee(s) remain unchanged.

We are hopeful this information provides clarification to the concerns you have submitted for consideration, and encourage you to contact us with any additional comments you may have related to the proposed rule changes.
