2 MS. JENNINGS: This public hearing will now come
3 to order on this 6th day of July 20154, at the West
4 Virginia Department of Environmental Protection
5 Headquarters. Comments and testimony will be accepted until
6 the close of this hearing and will be made part of the
7 rulemaking record. Any relevant question regarding
8 revisions to the rules will be included with your comments,
9 and any such question will be addressed as part of the
10 response to comments in the rulemaking record.

11 The purpose of this public hearing is to satisfy
12 state rulemaking requirements by accepting comments on
13 proposed revisions to rule 45CSR18 - *Control of Air*
14 *Pollution from Combustion of Solid Waste*. This rule adopts
15 standards of performance, and establishes emission
16 guidelines and compliance times pursuant to Sections 111(d)
17 and 129 of the federal Clean Air Act for the control of
18 certain designated pollutants from the following categories
19 of solid waste combustors, combustion units, incinerators
20 and incineration units in West Virginia. Revisions of the
21 rule comport with an April 18, 2014 decision by the U.S.
22 Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit. The DAQ will submit
23 the final rule to the U. S. EPA for approval as a part of

1 West Virginia's Section 111(d)/129 Plan and program
2 delegation of the federal New Source Performance Standards.

3 The floor is now open for comments.

4 There being nothing further, this public hearing
5 for proposed rule 45CSR18 is concluded.



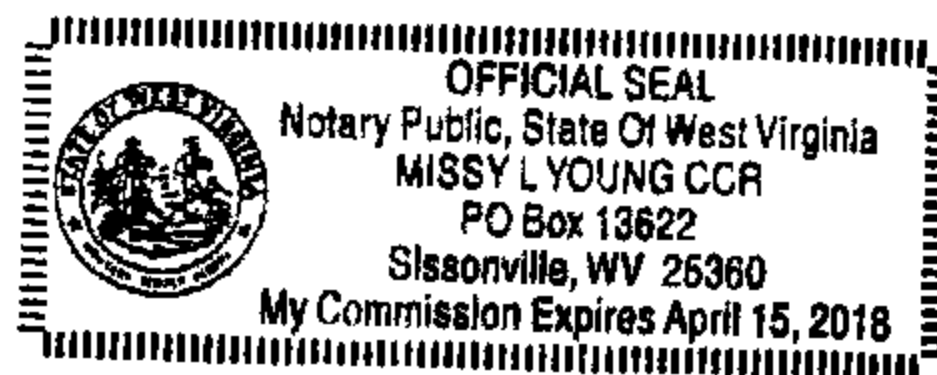

RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

On June 5, 2015, the Division of Air Quality (DAQ) commenced a thirty day public comment period and subsequently held a public hearing on July 6, 2015 to accept oral comments on proposed revisions to legislative rule 45CSR18. Written comments were also accepted through 6:00 PM on Monday, July 6, 2015. No commenter submitted written comments regarding proposed revisions to rule 45CSR18, and no commenter provided relevant verbal comment.
