## **Committee Amendment**

### **Rule Governing Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Assistants, 29CSR2**

The Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee moved to amend the Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology's proposed Rule Governing Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Assistants, 29CSR2 as follows:

On page 4, Subdivision 4.1.(y), following the word "than", by striking the word "two" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "three".

### **Statement of Reason**

The Committee amendment allows for a supervisor of speech-language pathology or audiology assistants to supervise no more than three full-time assistants at any one time.
