SUBJECT: Regarding rules and regulations of the West Virginia Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

Attention Mr. Wakefield:

I wish to submit the following changes in the rules and regulations of the above Examiners Board.

Rule 1, Section A. The proctor shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$35.00 per day for his or her services (old fee, \$15.00).

Rule Seven regarding Diagnostic and Analytical Instruments will be deleted, and in its place shall read as sections 10 article 16 of the code:

Any chiropractor who has complied with the provisions of this article may use any instrument, or procedure, for the purpose of diagnosis and analysis of disease, or abnormalities, provided such instruments are used in a school approved by the American Chiropractic Association, the International Chiropractic Association, or their successors.
