The comment requested an increase in examination fees to allow written and state law exams to be administered via computer based testing at certain locations in lieu of paper exams. Upon consideration, the Board chose to modify the proposed rule as requested.

Thank you for calling and speaking with me regarding a contract for 2017.

I contacted Iso Quality Testing (IQT), our sub-contractor for delivery of the Computer Based Testing (CBT) written and state law exams and the fee for a candidate to take the written and WV state law examination via CBT would be \$88.00. Our fee for the practical examination would be \$99.00. This would be a total fee for a first time candidate to take the practical, written and state law exam of \$187.00 so if you request an increase to the fee cap to \$190.00 that would cover it.

I will draft a proposed contract reflecting administering the written examinations via CBT and will e-mail to you shortly.
