Dear Ms. Cooper and Ms. Graham:

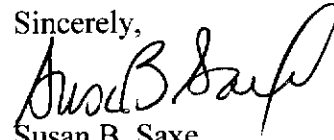
It is my understanding that Ms. Graham has contacted Betty S. Ireland, Executive Secretary of the West Virginia Consolidated Public Retirement Board ("Board"), to advise that the Title 162, Series 6 Rules which were previously submitted with proposed changes for review by the LRMRC and for approval by the Legislature are actually *procedural* rather than legislative rules. Such procedural rules, we understand, need not be submitted to the LRMRC nor presented to the Legislature for approval.

Under the circumstances, please consider this as our request to have the Title 162, Series 6 proposed rule changes withdrawn from consideration by the LRMRC and Legislature. We will, however, be processing our proposed changes to this set of procedural rules in a manner consistent with law, and will be in touch with Ms. Cooper regarding these proposed changes in the near future.
