**TITLE 15, SERIES 12 (WV CSR 15-12-1, et seq.)
RULES OF THE BOARD OF PHARMACY FOR IMMUNIZATIONS ADMINISTERED
BY PHARMACISTS AND PHARMACY INTERNS**

The Board of Pharmacy filed proposed rules with the Secretary of State on June 22, 2017, making amendments to Title 15, Series 12. As a matter of information, the Board circulated the rule among wholesale drug distributor stakeholders during the drafting process and incorporated certain suggestions at that time, prior to filing for public comment. The public comment period ended on July 24, 2017, at 4:00 p.m. The Board received one written public comment regarding the rules. Those comments from the WV Board of Medicine were in concurrence with the proposed amendments. The Board held a public meeting on July 26, 2017, to review the comments. Given that no comments requesting modifications to the rule were received, no further substantive changes were made.

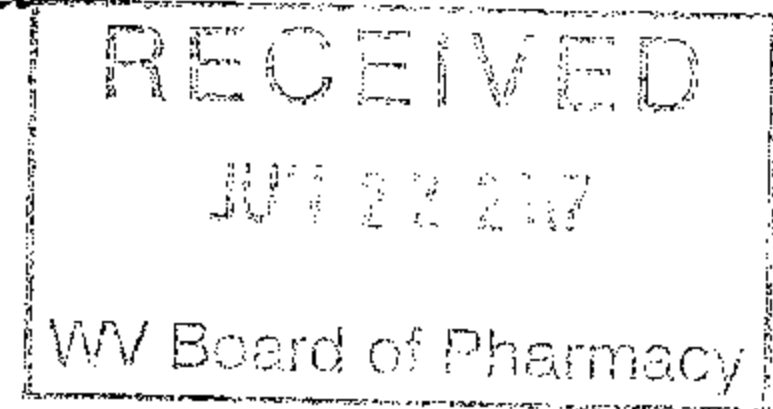
The Board then authorized this response and the proposed rules to be filed with the Secretary of State and the Legislative Rule-Making and Review Committee.
