

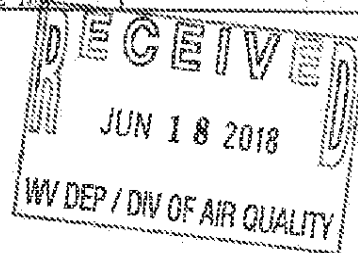
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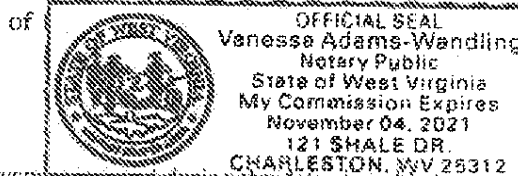

ALTERNATIVE TREATMENTS FOR CHRONIC PAIN MANAGEMENT

Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §1395aa(1)(C)(1)(i)(II) and 42 C.F.R. §447.206, the Department of Health and Human Resources ("Department"), Bureau for Medical Services ("BMS") provides notice of the filing of a state plan amendment (SPA), identified as SPA 18-001, regarding rules for alternative treatments for chronic pain. The SPA provides for 23 combined visits of physical therapy, occupational therapy, chiropractic manipulation, chiropractic services, or other non-surgical, non-pharmaceutical treatments related to a chronic pain management program, without need for a referral. This SPA is promulgated by Senate Bill 273, enacted by the Legislature and signed by the Governor in during the West Virginia 2018 Regular Legislative Session. Specifically, this SPA amends Code §20-2-5A-5A.

This SPA will be made effective on June 7, 2018, or as soon as CMS approves the SPA, whichever occurs first. The expenditure request for fiscal year 2018 and 2019 cannot be determined at this time.

The SPA and this notice will be available for public inspection in each county office of the Department of Health and Human Resources during normal business hours, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., beginning Wednesday, June 6, 2018 through Friday, July 6, 2018, and on the web at: www.dhhr.wv.gov/home then click "Public Notice" on the top toolbar.

22 air monitoring reference methods and equivalent methods

24 Revisions to this rule include amendments

1 promulgated by EPA under 40 CFR parts 50 and 53 as of
2 June 1st, 2018. Upon authorization and promulgation of

10 emissions trading programs. The trading programs
11 including the CSAPR Nox Annual Trading Program set forth
12 under 40 CFR part 97, subpart AAAAA. The CSAPR NOx Ozone
13 season group two trading program set forth under 40 CFR
14 part 97 subpart EEEEE and the CSAPRT SO2 Group One

16 subpart CCCCC.

17 This rule codifies general procedures and

22 Implementation Plan, or SIP, pursuant to the Federal
23 Clean Air Act.

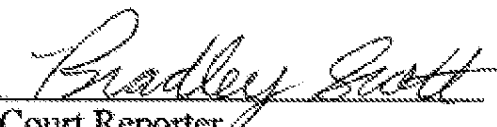
