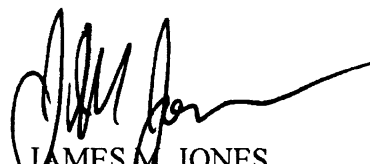
Dear Mr. Warner:

This program is now covered by the Course Management Plan, dated 1 May 2017, which replaced all former publications related to the Officer Candidate School. This governing document is produced and managed by the Maneuver Center at Ft. Benning, GA for all OCS programs Nationwide, to include programs at State ARNG Regional Training Institutes. The Army School System (TASS) revision and all TRADOC schools are governed through the CMP and POIs.
