Dear Ms. Cooper,

Please accept this request to automatically repeal Title 27, Series 4 – Restricted Practice Licensure for Addictions Counselors effective immediately. This rule was established as a result of HB 4061 that was passed by the Legislature in 2000 which amended W. Va. Code 30-31-7a, authorizing the WV Counseling Board to propose legislative rules for restricted practice licensure of addictions counselors. However, during the 2009 Legislative Session, W. Va. Code 30-31-7a, was Repealed, per Acts, 2009 Regular Session, Ch. 177. As a result, Title 27, Series 4 – Restricted Practice Licensure for Addictions Counselors is no longer in effect.
