Under Series 3, Registration of RVTs

Item 4.1.i is redundant and is in the wrong section, as this section is about *information* that the applicant provides; fees are mentioned elsewhere.

**Board's Response:**  
We have removed 4.1.i.

On page 7, the paragraph 7.5, final sentence begins: "No periods may be accumulated, carried forward, or held over...." It is not clear what "periods" means in this context, and it looks like a typographical error.

**Board's Response:**  
We have changed "period" to "units".

At the bottom of page 8, there is an extra and unnecessary "the" near the end of the last sentence in 7.14: "...no later than the 30 days from the action."

**Board's Response:**  
We have removed "the" in this sentence.

Under §26-3.9. Criminal History Record Check, it would be good to include details of where or how to get the criminal background check done. More than just the WV State Police will be needed.

**Board's Response:**  
We made no changes because the criminal background check details can change. Instructions on how to get a criminal background check is located on our website.
