The WV Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners met today and carefully considered your comments regarding the Series 1 rule changes.

We appreciate your frustration, and applaud the efforts of all our colleagues in the medical imaging and radiation therapy professions. However, changes to our Rules were mandated by passage of WV Senate Bill 396. This legislation REQUIRES that licensing fees be waived for all active members of the U.S. Armed Forces, National Guard or Reserves and their spouses, for the duration of their service and six months following discharge. The legislation also REQUIRES the waiving of licensing fees for individuals that meet state guidelines for low income (individuals with household adjusted gross incomes < 130% of the federal poverty line and/or enrollees in public assistance programs).

This legislation REQUIRES that licensing fees be waived for all active members of the U.S. Armed Forces, National Guard or Reserves and their spouses, for the duration of their service and six months following discharge.
