TITLE : NAMING or RENAMING of BUILDINGS or ORGANIZATIONAL UNITS

SECTION 1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Scope - Rule regarding the naming or renaming of buildings or organizational units at institutions in the State College System of West Virginia.
- 1.2 Authority - West Virginia Code § 18B-1-6
- 1.3 Filing Date - September 16, 1992
- 1.4 Effective Date - October 16, 1992
- 1.5 Repeal of Former Rule - Repeals and replaces Series 6 dated March 30, 1986.

SECTION 2. POLICY

- 2.1 Approval by the State College System Board of Directors is required for the naming or renaming of buildings and organizational units, such as schools and colleges, at institutions in the State College System.
- 2.2 The president of the institution, with the concurrence of the institutional board of advisors, is responsible for making the recommendation.
- 2.3 A building or organizational unit may be named for an individual if that individual has rendered distinguished service to the institution or made a significant contribution. The individual may not have been employed at the institution during the three (3) previous years.

§131-6-1. General.

§131-6-2. Policy.

2.1. Approval by the State College System Board of Directors is required for the naming or renaming of buildings and organizational units, such as schools and colleges, at institutions in the State College System.

2.2. The president of the institution, with the concurrence of the institutional board of advisors, is responsible for making the recommendation.

2.3. A building or organizational unit may be named for an individual if that individual has rendered distinguished service to the institution or made a significant contribution. The individual may not have been employed at the institution during the three (3) previous years.
