**RE:** Request to Lift the Temporary Suspension of Certain Provisions of Board of Medicine Rule 11 CSR 7

The West Virginia Board of Medicine is the state agency charged with protecting the health and safety of the public through licensure, regulation and oversight of medical doctors (MDs), podiatric physicians (DPMs), and collaborating physician assistants (PAs).

On March 26, 2020, and in accord with the Governor's March 16, 2020 Emergency Proclamation and Executive Orders 7-20 and 10-20, the Board filed a memorandum request with your office to impose a temporary rule suspension with respect to certain provisions of 11 CSR 7.

Today, the Board met and determined that while the State of Emergency which initially prompted the temporary rule suspension continues, the termination of this temporary rule suspension is appropriate at this time. Accordingly, the Board respectfully requests that the temporary rule suspension with respect to 11 CSR 7 be lifted or otherwise rescinded, effective today.
