I'm writing to you to request adding one more path to get a dental license in WV next year. For example PA, CA, NJ and other USA states if a dentist practice for 5 years in any USA state and in a good standing he or she can get a dental license in PA, CA, NJ and other state without looking to if the applicant went to CODA dental school or not.

I request WV to do the same as CA and other State.

I would like to tell you about my situation.

I am a general dentist who's been practicing dentistry in the United States since 2017 full time. I have 4 full active dental licenses to practice dentistry in (Mississippi 3917-17 , Washington state DE 60761109, Illinois 019.031933 and Arizona D010950). I have no complaints or actions against these licenses, and my background check is clear also my national practitioner data bank is clear.

I passed the national dental board exams part 1 and part 2. I passed the clinical licensing exam **on patients** ADEX /CDCA include Perio 2017. I got my Master degree in oral biology in Augusta dental school (24 months) from Augusta university in Georgia and I published my thesis.

I meet ALL the requirements to get a dental license in WV except the education requirement, since my dental school was overseas from non coda accredited school. I am a US citizen and want to pay taxes and work as a dentist in WV With My family to support them especially with COVID 19.

I have Report of Evaluation of Educational Credentials. It stated that my dental degree from Egypt equivalent of the US degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher education in the United States.

This Report of Evaluation of Educational Credentials helps me to meet the admission requirement at Augusta dental school to study MS in oral biology and Science. Please see the attachment.
