Re: 85 CSR 14, *Procedural Rules for the Workers' Compensation Board of Managers*

Ms. Lewis:

Please be advised that, at the November 18, 2021, meeting of the Workers' Compensation Industrial Council, the Industrial Council voted to repeal Title 85, Series 14, entitled *Procedural Rules for the Workers' Compensation Board of Managers*. The Workers' Compensation Board of Managers was terminated several years ago and, as such, a procedural rule regarding its meetings is unnecessary. Title 85 workers' compensation rules proposed by the Insurance Commissioner and approved by the Industrial Council are legislative exempt pursuant to W.Va. Code §23-2C-5(c)(2). Moreover, Title 85, Series 14 is also a procedural rule. In accordance with W.Va. Code St. R. §153-1-5.17, I am writing to provide you the following specific information, and request that the rule formally be repealed:
