Re: West Virginia Code of State Rules
– Administrative Notice for 175 CSR 2, specifically §5.1.1.f.

Dear Secretary of State Warner:

The Honorable Governor of the State of West Virginia, Jim Justice, has declared a State of Emergency on March 16, 2020, to address the emergency created by the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic, or more commonly known as the novel coronavirus.

On March 18, 2020, the WVABCA in response to the Governor's Executive Order (EO) No. 2-20 issued on March 18, 2020, temporarily suspended the above-mentioned rule pursuant to the Governor's executive orders.

The West Virginia Alcohol Beverage Control Administration (WVABCA) temporarily suspended §5.1.1.f. of 175 CSR 2, however, the WVABCA has amended the rule with its filing on July 1, 2022 and the rule suspension is no longer needed. Please withdraw the previous rule suspension.
