STATE-COUNTY TESTING PROGRAM (2340)

§126-14-1. General.     \_\_

1.1. Scope. -- This legislative rule established that achievement and scholastic attitude tests be given annually in specified grades. \_\_

1.2. Authority. -- W.Va. Code §18-2-5

1.3. Filing Date. -- November 5, 1964

1.4. Effective Date. -- January 5, 1965

§126-14-2. Requirements.

Request all counties to administer annually an achievement battery and a test of scholastic aptitude in grades 3, 6, 9 and 11. However, permit counties to participate in less than four grades of testing (from among the above grades) so long as they test in the grade specified for statewide study during any given year and agree to test in all four grades every fourth year. The schedule of grades for statewide study beginning with school year 1965-66 will be as follows: First year, grade 6; second year, grade 3; third year, grade 9; fourth year, grades 3, 6, 9 and 11. This cycle will be repeated every fourth year.

STATE-COUNTY TESTING PROGRAM

The Board adopted the following policy, revising its previous action, with respect to the State-County Testing Program:

Request all counties to administer annually an achievement battery and a test of scholastic aptitude in grades 3, 6, 9, and 11. However, permit counties to participate in less than four grades of testing (from among the above grades) so long as they test in the grade specified for state-wide study during any given year and agree to test in all four grades every fourth year. The schedule of grades for state-wide study beginning with school year 1965-66 will be as follows: First year, grade 6; second year, grade 3; third year, grade 9; fourth year, grades 3, 6, 9 and 11. This cycle will be repeated every fourth year. - - 11/5/64
