This rule directs the Bureau for Public Health, in cooperation with other state agencies and attending physicians, to provide medical, dietary, and related assistance to children determined to be afflicted with any disease specified in W. Va. Code 16-22-3, and certain other diseases specified by the Bureau for Public Health.

SUMMARIZE IN A CLEAR AND CONCISE MANNER THE REASONS FOR REQUESTING A SUNSET PROVISION EXTENSION:

This rule provides a means for any further referral or treatment services considered necessary by the Bureau for Public Health to implement the provisions of the statute on newborn screening. This rule should be read in conjunction with W. Va. Code 16-22-3 and 16-22A-1 et seq. and the rule on Newborn Hearing Screening, 64CSR24.
