

Requirements Governing Water Quality Standards

The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection's (WVDEP) Division of Water and Waste Management (DWWM) will conduct a public hearing at Coopers Rock Conference Hall, WVDEP on proposed changes to Legislative Rule 47 C.S.R. 02, "Requirements Governing Water Quality Standards."

A. SUMMARY OF RULE:

This rule establishes the requirements governing the discharge or deposit of sewage, industrial wastes, and other wastes into the waters of the state and establishes water quality standards for the waters of the State standing or flowing over the surface of the State.

B. STATEMENT OF CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH REQUIRE RULE:

WVDEP is proposing to amend the "Requirements Governing Water Quality Standards", by updating the water quality standards.
