This rule establishes the method of registration for architects in West Virginia, along with the continuing education requirements and the rules of professional conduct.

Registering architects based upon the qualifications of education, experience, and examination is still essential to protect the public in the built environment. Requiring and auditing continuing education with the changes in building materials and methods is necessary, along with the an expectation of professional conduct to protect the consumer.
