Hi Linda

Since the board is opening the rule for updating, I would like to propose updating the "man hours" requirements for OJT. Currently, Regional Sanitarians are required to complete 64 total hours (32 food, 32 other) with new Sanitarians. Given the current staffing levels, this can create a hardship for them. It has also been my experience that some Sanitarians, particularly Sanitarians in larger Health Departments, simply don't require a full 32 hours of evaluation because they have received extensive training by the time they receive OJT. Additionally, now that several counties have enrolled in the voluntary retail standards, I believe that it is in our best interest to modify the OJT process to make it more in line with retail Standard 2.

Standard 2 requires new field inspectors to complete a minimum of 25 joint field inspections that *"are to be comprised of both "demonstration" (trainer led) and "training" (trainee led) inspections and include a variety of retail food establishment types available within the jurisdiction."* The majority of these joint inspections would be with other sanitarians at their health department (unless they are a 1 person health department of course). I propose that Food OJT would consist of at least 5 'trainee led' inspections, with at least one inspection in each of the current food establishment categories. A sanitarian would need a score of at least 80% on their evaluation in each facility category to successfully complete the OJT process. Of course, the Regional Sanitarian can provide additional training and/or require additional evaluations if they feel the Sanitarian needs additional guidance. I developed the OJT audit form that is currently in use, and it would only need minimal tweaking to meet the requirements for an audit form in Standard 2. The current audit form was also designed to accommodate the other programs, which could follow a similar pattern. Please feel free to reach out to me if you have any questions or would like to have any additional discussion.

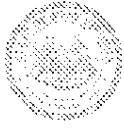

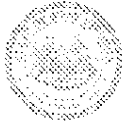

Hello, Linda!

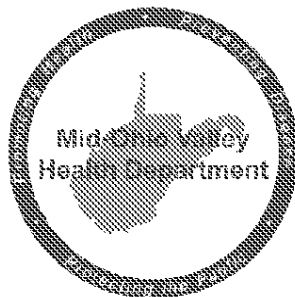
