Dear Maureen:

Pursuant to WV legislative rule 175 CSR 6, specifically §§ 8.5, 11.1., and 11.2., the attached Table 1 amended is being amended by publication on December 19, 2024, which will be effective March 18, 2025.

The relevant sections are as follows:

“11.1. Suppliers doing business with ABCC under the bailment inventory system will be charged for routine warehousing services, such charges will be deducted from the amount due the suppliers for withdrawals of their stock from bailment inventory.”
... **“The amount of such charges will be imposed by administrative notices filed in the State Register.”**

11.2. ABCC may also impose handling fees when extra services are performed. Examples of extra services and charges are as follows: (See Table 1 at the end of this rule.)”

At the direction of the Commissioner, Table 1 is being amended to clarify certain warehouse charges and the timing of filing amendments.
