SUMMARY OF THE CONTENT OF THE LEGISLATIVE RULE, AND A DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE RULE'S PURPOSE AND ALL PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE RULE:

This rule is a further step in the implementation of the One Stop Permitting Program enacted by the West Virginia Legislature, at the request of the Governor, in House Bill 2002. That Program seeks to revolutionize and streamline West Virginia's permitting system by creating an online dashboard for processing and tracking permits for construction, economic development, infrastructure, and natural resource projects. In turn, this dashboard will increase transparency and efficiency in agency permitting, streamline the review process, and accelerate business and economic development throughout the State. The Program is also set to create a fast track option allowing developers of urgent projects to pay an additional fee to ensure their time sensitive permits are expedited.

This rule provides information to potential permit holders of the upcoming deadline and associated fees that will come into effect upon full implementation. The rule defines key terms, sets specific deadlines for agencies to process permits filed through the One-Stop Permitting Program's Dashboard, and enumerates fees for each permit. The Rule also identifies fees associated with electing for a "fast-track permit by paying an additional fee. Finally, the rule clarifies that permitting agencies failing to meet the deadlines established in the rule must refund applicant fees.

STATEMENT OF CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH REQUIRE THE RULE:

House Bill 2002, establishing One-Stop Shop Permitting Process, passed during the 2025 Legislative Session. The legislation requires the Department of Administration to promulgate a rule related to the One-Stop-Shop Permitting Program

SUMMARIZE IN A CLEAR AND CONCISE MANNER THE OVERALL ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED LEGISLATIVE RULE:

A. ECONOMIC IMPACT ON REVENUES OF STATE GOVERNMENT:

Adopting the rule will create procedures for the One-Stop-Shop Permitting program, which will streamline statewide economic development efforts by ensuring business partners can apply for, find, and track key business permits in one convenient location. This Program and Dashboard will make it easier for applicants to apply and receive permits in West Virginia. Clarified deadlines, upcoming fast-track deadlines, and corresponding fees will improve the permit processing and make it easier to begin doing business in West Virginia.

This program will enhance West Virginia's business-friendly posture by increasing efficiency and improving transparency. Further, the data collected and maintained through this process will help West Virginia's agencies evaluate and improve current processes, creating an opportunity for growth, development, and increased competition with neighboring states.

**B. ECONOMIC IMPACT ON SPECIAL REVENUE ACCOUNTS:**

When fully implemented, the rule will establish new fees in the form of fast track fees, allowing permit applicants to request fast-track consideration, for quicker investment in the State.

**C. ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE LEGISLATIVE RULE ON THE STATE OR ITS RESIDENTS:**

The Program and this related rule are designed to revolutionize and streamline West Virginia's permitting system. It is designed to make West Virginia more competitive in relation to the neighboring states by reducing red-tape and decreasing permitting review time.

The rule and Program will attract and encourage business development by simplifying and streamlining the permit application process. Construction, economic development, infrastructure, and natural resource projects are a core piece of West Virginia's economic success. Creating a welcoming regulatory environment for these types of projects is key to generating jobs and economic growth.

**E. EXPLANATION OF ABOVE ESTIMATES (INCLUDING LONG-RANGE EFFECT):**

As provided in W. Va. Code § 5A-13-3(c), the program and the permitting deadlines in this rule will take effect on January 1, 2027. While the costs of implementation are unknown at this time, the Secretary of Administration, through the State Purchasing Division, began the process to identify the scope of potential solutions and costs. The Department anticipates a portion of the costs will be offset by fees, as provided in Code. Additionally, the increased revenues resulting from an increase in permits and an uptick in statewide project development will offset the overall Program cost.

After performing market research and developing a general concept of system requirements and needs, the Purchasing Division published a Request for Information (RFI) to allow vendors to submit information regarding proposed solutions to meet the needs as set forth in Code. Potential vendors have shown high engagement in the RFI process thus far by providing a number of clarifying questions. Answers were posted on August 21, 2025, giving vendors additional information prior to finalizing and submitting their informational proposals.

In the next few weeks, the vendors responses will be used to develop a Request for Proposal (RFP). The RFP will be posted, allowing vendors to submit formal bids on the project. Ultimately, the RFP will result in a final award to the vendor who will develop and implement the One-Stop-Shop Permitting Portal.

ONE-STOP-SHOP PERMITTING PROGRAM

§148-25-1. General.

1.1. Scope. -- This rule implements deadlines and procedures for the One-Stop Shop Permitting Program to expedite the state's permitting, licensing, and authorization processes.

1.2. Authority. -- W. Va. Code § 5A-13-1 et seq.

1.3. Filing Date. --

1.4. Effective Date. --

1.5. Sunset Provision -- This rule shall terminate and have no further force and effect on August 1, 2031.

§148-25-2. Definitions.

2.1. For the purposes of this rule:

2.1.1. "Complete Permit Application" means a request for the issuance or renewal of a permit that contains all information, signatures, supporting evidence, and payments necessary for a permitting agency to process and approve the permit.

2.1.2. "Day" means business days for any review or fast track deadline value of ten (10) or less and calendar days for any value of ten (10) or greater, unless otherwise specified.

2.1.3. "Dashboard" means the publicly accessible, interactive, online platform created by the Department of Administration to facilitate the filing, issuance, and renewal of permits through the One-Stop-Shop Permitting Program.

2.1.4. "Department" means the Department of Administration.

2.1.5. "Economic Development Project" means a commercial, industrial, community improvement, or preservation project resulting from a strategic and coordinated effort which is likely to foster local or state economic growth.

2.1.6. "Fast-Track" means an option for an applicant to request expedited processing of a permit application for a fee.

2.1.7. "Permit" - means any permit, license, or approval that is a prerequisite for performing any economic development project and that is available and applied for using the One-Stop-Shop Permitting Program dashboard. A permit includes, but is not limited to, projects for construction; economic development; infrastructure; or natural resource project in this state that a permitting agency issues, grants, modifies, renews, denies, or revokes.

2.1.8. “Permitting agency” means any division, office, board, or other entity of the Department of Commerce, the Department of Environmental Protection, the Office of Environmental Health Services, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Tourism, the Department of Transportation, and the Secretary of State that grants, issues, denies, or revokes a permit or business registration. Per W. Va. Code §5A-13-2, permitting agency does not include Lottery, Lottery Commission, the Division of Financial Institutions, or the Division of Motor Vehicles.

2.1.9. “Program” means the One-Stop-Shop Permitting Program created in W. Va. Code §5A-13-1 et seq. designed to enhance public awareness, collaboration, accountability, coordination, transparency, and predictability in the state’s permitting, licensing, and authorization process.

2.1.10. “Secretary” means the cabinet secretary for the Department of Administration.

**§148-25-3. Permit Processing Deadlines.**

3.1. If a deadline for agencies to process a Program permit does not exist in statute or regulation, Attachment A to this rule establishes one.

3.1.1. Permitting agencies shall follow the processing deadlines in Attachment A for any permit applied for through the Program when:

3.1.1.a. Determining the completeness of an application.

3.1.1.b. Denying a complete permit application.

3.1.1.c. Approving a complete permit application, or

3.1.1.d. Renewing a complete permit application.

3.2. The deadline to process a permit begins when the permit is filed in the Dashboard.

3.3. Permit processing deadlines apply only to activities performed by and under the control of a permitting agency. If a permitting agency must rely on a second, external agency to provide information or perform a step of the permitting process, the permitting agency’s deadline pauses when the permitting agency submits a request to the external agency. The deadline timer restarts when the external agency completes the requested task or provides the necessary information. Time taken by the external agency to perform the task or provide information is not charged against the permitting agency’s deadline.

3.4. When a deadline to process a Fast-Track permit falls beyond the regular business hours of the permitting agency, the timer stops when the permitting agency’s office closes and restarts when business resumes the next business day.

3.5. If a permitting agency rejects or denies a permit, the agency deadline or fast track deadline resets and begins anew when an applicant files an updated or corrected version.

3.6. Processing deadlines established in Attachment A shall become applicable and effective when the Secretary makes the Program available to the public pursuant to W. Va. Code §5A-13-3(c).

**§148-25-4. Fast Track.**

**148CSR25**

4.1. If a permitting agency offers fast track consideration, the agency deadline and associated fee to expedite the processing of a Program permit application is established in Attachment A to this rule.

4.1.1. Fast track fees included in Attachment A represent the total cost for filing the permit application and fast track processing combined.

4.2. Fast track deadlines and fees become applicable and effective when the secretary makes the Program available to the public pursuant to W. Va. Code §5A-13-3(c).

**148-25-5. Refunds.**

5.1. Beginning on January 1, 2027, any permitting agency failing to meet a deadline established in Attachment A when determining completeness, granting, or denying a permit that was processed through the dashboard, must refund all fees paid by the applicant for that permit.
