PLEASE PROVIDE A BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE CONTENT OF THE RULE:

The Insurance Commissioner seeks to amend the rule solely to extend the sunset date, which is currently August 1, 2027. The rule is necessary for the Insurance Commissioner to implement W. Va. Code §§33-12-8 and 33-12B-13 with respect to the continuing education requirements for insurance producers and adjusters. The rule provides definitions, exemptions, continuing insurance education requirements and disciplinary provisions. The rule was last updated in 2022 as a result of House Bill 2682 (2021) to allow for notices of insurance producer and adjuster license suspensions for failing to timely complete continuing education requirements to be sent to insurance producers and adjusters via electronic mail or regular mail if elected.

The rule is necessary for the Insurance Commissioner to implement W. Va. Code §§33-12-8 and 33-12B-13 with respect to the continuing education requirements for insurance producers and adjusters. Thus, the Insurance Commissioner is requesting a sunset provision extension.
