

**Title 64 Series 112
Department of Health
Bureau for Public Health
Medical Cannabis Program - Dispensaries**

Summary of Amendments to the Rule:

The rule has been amended to remove the definitions of terms already defined within the West Virginia Code, clarify processes for verification of patient identity, and add a requirement that dispensaries have a redundant power supply for the prevention of theft, spoilage, or degradation.

COMMENTS AND RESPONSES

The descriptions of public comments below are a paraphrasing of the originally submitted comments. The full text of each public comment has been filed with the Secretary of State's Office.

Comment

Two public comments were received. The commenters suggest that the Department of Health consider utilizing scannable technology to provide product information allowing patients to receive product information and testing results.

Response

The Department of Health is willing to continue evaluation of the future use of scannable technology to provide product information for technical and fiscal feasibility; however, until such evaluation is complete, explicit inclusion in the core regulatory structure is premature at this time. Therefore, the proposed amendment is declined and no changes were made to the rule in response to this comment.
