Title: Four-Year Education Plan

Section 1. General

1.1 Scope - These rules require the development of a Four-Year Education Plan created cooperatively by parents, school personnel, and the student for all eighth grade students. This policy is to be effective for eighth grade students that will be entering the ninth grade in the 1990-91 school year.

1.2 Authority - W. Va. Code 18-2-5

Section 2. Purpose

2.1 The purpose of this policy is to direct students into a program that upon completion will have prepared them for either entry into college or for employment. Students will develop a plan for attending technical education, college preparation, a combination of these two, or fine arts.

Section 3. Requirements

3.1 Counties may use the plan in Appendix A or they may develop and use their own Four-Year Education Plan which contains these components:

- 1) List of courses per grade level including credits
- 2) Career plans and Educational Goals
- 3) Extracurricular activities
- 4) Personal identification information
- 5) Assessment scores (if available) including ACT and/or SAT
- 6) Signature of Parent/Guardian

3.2 The Four-Year Education Plan will be jointly developed by the parents, teacher/advisor/counselor, and student to provide guidelines and short- and long-term goals.

3.3 The Four-Year Education Plan will be used to assist students in making a reasoned, well-informed career choice that is based upon the student's interests, aptitudes, abilities, previous work experience, personal traits, and desired future life style.

3.4 The Four-Year Education Plan will establish an individual file for maintaining career decision-making information throughout the student's school years. It will be an ongoing resource and information tool.

3.5 The Four-Year Education Plan will be flexible and reviewed periodically and revised as necessary.

3.6 The Four-Year Education Plan format must be sent to the State Superintendent of Schools for approval by November 1, 1989.
