THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES CONSTITUTING THE EMERGENCY ARE AS FOLLOWS:

This emergency rule is needed to permit a coordinated and comprehensive response by the State Board of Education and the State Superintendent of Schools to the current teacher work stoppage. It describes provisions for the emergency licensure of teaching personnel for West Virginia public schools. This policy has no fiscal impact for FY 91. It has no known fiscal impact for subsequent years.
