

EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

SUBJECT: REGISTRATION FORMS AND TAGS FOR REGISTRATION, TAXATION AND CONTROL OF DOGS

Section 1. General

1.01. Scope - These regulations establish general operating rules and procedures in the Animal Disease Control Division. These are Legislative Regulations. THESE ARE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS.

1.02. Authority - These regulations are issued under authority of Chapter 19, Article 20, Section 4, Code of West Virginia.

1.03. Effective Date - These regulations are promulgated and become effective on December 1, 1984.

1.04. Filing Date - These regulations were filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on November 30, 1984.

1.05. General Purpose - Regulations to prevent, suppress, control and eradicate communicable diseases of dogs.

Section 2. Certificate of Registration

2.01. The Certificate of Registration and the carbon copy thereof shall contain the following information:

- (a) Year for which tax is paid
- (b) Serial number of Certificate of Registration.
- (c) Registration tag number.

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- (d) Date
- (e) Name of owner (keeper or harborer)
- (f) Address
- (g) District
- (h) Description of dog
- (i) Head tax - required fee \$3.00
- (j) Amount collected

Section 3. Record of Registration

3.01. The certificate of Registration forms shall be numbered serially and bound in Books. A duplicate, non-perforated carbon copy of the Certificate of Registration shall be left in the book as a record.

3.02. Each dog shall be issued a registration tag when the certificate of registration is issued.

Section 4. Registration Tags

4.01. Registration tags shall be manufactured of metal or some other suitable substance of a permanent nature and designed with a hole in each end one-sixteenth of an inch in diameter, so that it can be safely and securely attached to the animal's collar. The tag shall bear the imprint "W.V. Dog Tax", the county, year and serial number. Provided, however, that any assessor in any County in the State who has forms or tags previously prescribed by the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allowed to use the same until the present supply is exhausted, at which time the forms and tags designated by the regulation shall be procured and used. Dogs shall wear a valid registration tag at all times.

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4.02. The Registration tag number shall be recorded on the Certificate of Registration.

4.03. Municipalities may prescribe their own registration tags for dogs, but they must be clearly distinguishable from those issued by the Commissioner.
