PROMULGATION HISTORY

The proposed procedural regulations were filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on May 19, 1981 and went to public notice on the same date -- comment period closing on June 18, 1981.

They were filed in the Secretary of State's Office after adoption on June 29, 1981, with an effective date July 29, 1981.

Proposed changes/additions/amendments/deletions to Series V of the Board's Administrative Regulations were duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on April 26, 1984 for inclusion in the State Register, comment period closing on May 26, 1984.

On June 25, 1984 by proper motion and vote the Board adopted the proposed changes to Series V Administrative Regulations and they were duly filed with the Secretary of State on June 27, 1984 with an effective date of July 27, 1984.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3, Article 9A, Chapter 6 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, the Water Resources Board is a governing body required to promulgate a regulation by which the time and place of all regularly scheduled meetings, all hearings, and the time, place and purpose of all special meetings are made available, in advance, to the public and news media, except in the event of an emergency requiring immediate official action;

~~NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROMULGATED BY THE BOARD:~~ *e*

*Section 2 Rules*

2.1. The Board shall file with the Secretary of State's Office a Notice containing the time, date and place of all regularly scheduled meetings of the Board. Said Notice must be filed with that office at least seven (7) days in advance.

2.2. The Board shall file with the Secretary of State's Office a Notice or Notices containing the time, date and place of all Appeal hearings to be heard by the Board pursuant to Code 20-5A-15. Said Notice shall be filed with the Secretary of State at least seven (7) days before the date set for the hearing.

2.3. The Board shall file with the Secretary of State's Office a Notice containing the time, date, place and purpose of all special meetings to be held by the Board. Said Notice must be filed with that office at least seven (7) days in advance.

2.4. Copies of all Notices required to be filed by this Regulation with the Secretary of State's Office shall also be delivered to the Capitol News Media, Room MB-46, State Capitol.

2.5. None of the provisions of this Regulation shall apply to Board actions taken in the event of an emergency requiring immediate action.

2.6. None of the provisions of this Regulation shall apply to Board meetings held for the purpose of making an adjudicatory decision.

~~2.7. These rules were adopted on the 25th day of June, 1984 and  
become effective on the 27th day of July, 1984.~~
