NOTICE OF EMERGENCY RULE

RULE TITLE: Hazardous Substance Emergency Response Training Program.

The attached rule is filed as an Emergency Rule. The facts and circumstances constituting the emergency are as follows:

Pursuant to HB 1266 (1986), West Virginia State Code §29-3-5a and §55-7-17, individuals certified under these rules and regulations will not be held liable for civil damages as a result of their assistance to emergency response personnel at incidents involving hazardous substances.

In as much as incidents involving hazardous substances occur without warning and constitute a danger to the public and the environment, implementation of this program at the earliest possible time will provide a more timely response of personnel, especially from the chemical industry, to incidents involving hazardous substance and subsequently provide more timely assistance to emergency response forces, such as fire and police in their efforts to mitigate the incident.
