Dear Sirs:

This is in reference to your request that the proposed revisions to the State Board of Health's "Radiological Health Regulations" be presented to the new Board of Health appointed in accordance with SB 585.

I regret to advise you that we have failed to have a quorum at meetings since July 1, 1977, and therefore the Board has been unable to act on these regulations.

As the 180 day limitation for consideration by the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee expires on February 6, 1978, I wish to withdraw these regulations from consideration. As soon as possible they will be presented to the present Board of Health for promulgation and, if approved, will be resubmitted to your Committee, the Secretary of State and the Governor.

Thank you for bringing to our attention the Committee's concern on the legality of our previous submittal.
