Introduction

This report and the directories of licensed nursing and personal care homes implements the requirements of Chapter 16, Article 5, Section 3(r) of the West Virginia Code as amended by the 1977 legislature*.

The basic structure of this report describes the licensing and investigatory activities concerning nursing and personal care homes in West Virginia. This report also includes a brief discussion of Medicare/Medicaid certification survey activity.

* "In the administration of this article, the director (of health) shall have the following powers, duties, and rights:

(r) To submit a report to the governor, the legislature and the public, on or before the first day of December, one thousand nine hundred seventy-eight, and annually thereafter. The report shall describe the licensing and investigatory activities of the department during the year, and the nature and status of other activities of the department, and may include comment on the acts, policies, practices or procedures of any public or private agency that affect the rights, health or welfare of patients or residents of nursing homes and personal care homes. The annual report shall include a list of all nursing homes and personal care homes in the State; whether such homes are proprietary or nonproprietary; the classification of each such home; the name of the owner or owners; the total number of beds, the number of private and semi-private rooms; the costs per diem for private patients; the number of full-time employees and their professions; recreational programs; services and programs available as well as the costs thereof, the rating assigned to the home by the department pursuant to section five (§16-5C-5) of this article, and whether or not those nursing homes listed accept medicare and medicaid patients. The report shall also contain the department's recommendations as to changes in law or policy which it deems necessary or appropriate for the protection of the rights, health or welfare of patients of nursing homes and personal care homes in the State. (Chapter 16, Article 5C, Section 3, West Virginia Code, 1931, as amended.)

Health Facilities Evaluation Division

The Health Facilities Evaluation Division is responsible for monitoring the compliance of all health care facilities with state licensing regulations. It also monitors facility compliance with standards for participation in the Medicare/Medicaid reimbursements programs. Under present arrangements, on-site surveys of mental health and related facilities are conducted by the Division of Behavioral Health Services.

Based on the finding of on-site surveys, the division makes recommendations to the director of health for the licensure of all types of health facilities required to be licensed; and to the Department of Health and Human Services, Health Care Financing Administration for Medicare (Title XVIII) and to the State Department of Human Services for Medicaid (Title XIX) participation or continued participation in those reimbursement programs. Other responsibilities include complaint investigations, site approval of new construction, determination of compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act, and in the case of facility certification, fire safety inspections. For licensure fire safety inspections are currently the responsibility of the State Fire Marshal's Office.

Medicare/Medicaid reimbursements for individuals are not handled through this division. That role is carried out by the West Virginia Department of Human Services and the intermediaries.

Nursing Homes

If during an on-site survey licensure deficiencies are cited, surveyors are required to make return visits to check for correction of deficiencies before the issuance of renewal licenses. Surveyors also provide consultative services to facilities in all areas of nursing home construction, maintenance and operation in addition to that occurring during the standard survey/resurvey procedures. These consultative services also include updating and/or preparation of appropriate educational and institutional materials.

A summary of surveys and other facility visitation from the period of November 1, 1982 to October 31, 1983 is shown on Table 1 below. Generally, surveys may take from two to four man days. The amount of time is determined by the number of surveyors, travel time, and the number and types of deficiencies identified.

Of the 82 licensed nursing homes, 50 have a Class I license, 10 have a Class II license, and 22 are pending licensure. Nursing home licenses are not issued until facilities are in compliance with the Health Care Facility Financial Disclosure Law, which will be monitored by the Health Facilities Evaluation Division effective December 1, 1983.

Personal Care Homes

Personal care homes are surveyed for state licensure only since they are not eligible for participation in the Medicare or Medicaid programs. Last year there were 49 licensed personal care homes in West Virginia. Twenty-eight facilities have been given Class I licenses, 16 have Class II licenses, 5 have provisional licenses, and 3 applications are pending, making a potential total of 52 licensed personal care homes.

All 52 of these facilities have received a licensure survey and there have been 36 revisits, exclusive of complaint investigations which are reported separately below.

Complaint Investigation

On-site investigation of complaints is carried out by the program staff under the coordination of the Complaint Coordinator. During this period of time, 201 complaints were received. Of that total, 22 were hospital related, 62 were generated on nursing homes, 14 on personal care homes, 98 on unlicensed facilities, 2 on independent laboratories, 1 on rehabilitation center; and 2 on renal dialysis centers.

Of the 201 complaints, 65 were substantiated upon investigation and some form of corrective action was required.

All complaints received by this office are investigated. Each complaint is screened to determine the nature and degree of the alleged threat to life and/or safety of patients and whether or not there is a need for emergency action.

Unlicensed Facilities

Unlicensed facilities constitute a major problem in West Virginia. The following is a distillation of the essential state licensure requirements and definitions of nursing and personal care facilities. A complete description of minor variances is not presented here since it is beyond the scope of this report.

A facility providing personal care is required to be licensed if it provides personal care for six or more individuals. It must, therefore, meet state licensure standards and be inspected at least once a year. If it provides care for five or fewer patients, it is not subject to licensure regulations or periodic monitoring unless it participates in the Adult Family Care

Program, a voluntary program which is administered by the State Department of Human Services. A facility which provides nursing care for more than two individuals must be licensed and meet state licensure standards. The State Department of Health has no authority over facilities that fall outside these limits.

Some of the complaints received concern facilities which are small enough not to require a license. In such cases a visit is made to determine the census. No further action can be taken under existing state law.

A problem of much larger magnitude exists in the case of facilities which have a sufficiently large census and require licensure, but which try by various means to evade the state licensure laws. Such facilities often claim that they are only boarding homes or group residential facilities and as such are not subject to regulation by the state. In other instances, the census may be temporarily reduced, thus appearing to conform to the law, only to be increased at a later date. The purpose of such action is to escape scrutiny until another complaint is received.

Several other factors should be noted. The problem with some facilities is most commonly failure to meet fire safety standards, although abuses in sanitation and patient care do occur frequently. In many instances such facilities, though inadequate, do serve a need in the community since there are significant numbers of people who need some form of care and for whom no other resources are available.

Nevertheless, the Department takes a strong position regarding patient safety and welfare, and is making some progress in dealing with illegally operating facilities, thereby avoiding tragedies in which lives may be needlessly lost.

Regulation and Statute Revision

The health reorganization also mandated some very extensive changes in the law regarding the licensing of nursing and personal care homes, particularly with respect to administration and enforcement. It also mandated a system of rating of facilities as "A", "B", "C", and "F" and a classification and point system for standards for the facilities. Although the law mandated that new regulations be in effect by March 1978, this has proven to be an impossible goal.

A nursing home regulation draft, produced by the Governor's Office of Health Affairs, was judged to need major revision. A committee composed of representatives of the department, other state agencies, providers and various advocacy groups was organized to work on another draft. This effort proved to be cumbersome and it was difficult to allocate sufficient staff time for this very extensive and time-consuming effort. In an attempt to complete the revision, a consultant firm was hired to produce a draft set of regulations.

A public hearing was held in March, 1981 on proposed nursing home regulations prepared by the consultant firm. Many comments and suggested revisions and amendments were received. The department and Board of Health decided that a revision of the standards, point and rating system was necessary. The consultant firm was no longer used after this hearing due to lack of funds.

Another draft was approved by the Board of Health in November, 1981 after field testing. A public hearing was held in February, 1982. Following minor revisions, it was submitted to the Legislative Rule Making Review Committee in August, 1982.

The Legislative Rule Making Review Committee discussed the regulations at several meetings, including taking public comment twice, and also approved a few additional changes. The regulations were submitted to the 1983 Legislature, were approved with committee amendments, and became effective June 6, 1983.

After comprehensive surveys of nursing homes, it has been determined that some minor changes to the new regulations may need to be incorporated.

In addition, a first draft of personal care home regulation changes has been developed.

FOREWORD

The information contained in this directory has been gathered from three sources. Where possible, it has been taken from licensing and/or certification files.

Some information, in particular the per diem rates and employee statistics, has been taken from the Cooperative Health Statistics System, in which case the information is provided by the facility. This information is not substantiated by on-site reviews.

An important caution in using this directory is that the per diem rate usually does not cover all services listed. Detailed information concerning services available is not available for personal care homes. In considering facilities, careful inquiry should be made as to what services are included in the basic per diem rate.
