BAKERY REGULATIONS**

§64-43-1. General

1.1. Scope - These legislative rules establish the minimum sanitary requirements for bakeries.

1.2. Authority - W. Va. Code §16-1-7

1.3. Filing Date - November 28, 1967

1.4. Effective Date - December 29, 1967

§64-43-2. Application and Enforcement

2.1. Application - These legislative rules apply to the owners and operators of bakeries.

2.2. Enforcement - The enforcement of these legislative rules is vested with the director of the West

Virginia department of health or his lawful designee.

§64-43-3. Sanitation Requirements

All employees of bakeries shall wear clean, washable clothing and shall keep their hands and persons scrupulously clean at all times while engaged in handling of food for public consumption. All bakeries shall be located in such places that they can be kept sanitary at all times and so constructed that rodents cannot gain access and screened in such manner as to exclude flies and other insects. All bread before marketing shall be wrapped in clean paper and products such as cakes, doughnuts, etc., shall be kept covered at all times. All storage compartments in the bakery and in delivery trucks shall be so constructed that they can be kept sanitary and so that flies and vermin are excluded.
