

Please note that no comments (written or oral) were received regarding amendments to the "Sale and Distribution of Commercial Fertilizer" regulations.

To briefly summarize the proposed changes, they are necessary to achieve national uniformity and consistency with the Association of American Plant Feed Control Officials, Inc. They will serve to exempt hydroponic or continuous liquid feeding products from the minimum percentage guarantee requirement for secondary and micro-nutrient elements.

PUBLIC COMMENT SOLICITED ON STATE FERTILIZER REGULATIONS

Charleston, W.Va.--Agriculture Commissioner Gus R. Douglass announced he will receive public comments concerning a proposed revision to the State Fertilizer Regulations which would exempt continuous liquid feeding (hydroponic) materials from the minimum percentage guarantees for secondary or micro-nutrient elements.

Douglass said the standards, adopted in 1974, are still applicable to mixed fertilizer but are not realistic for continuous liquid feeding purposes. He said the proposed exemption would make the State regulations consistent with the Association of American Plant Food Control Officials' recommended model regulations.
