3. Permits.

SEC. 3. PERMITS.

Effective September 1, 1973 it shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess a permit from the State Department of Health or in the case of a raw producer dairy (direct shippers) possess a permit from the health officer of the county receiving the milk for processing to send, bring, receive, have for sale, sell, offer for sale, or to have in storage in the State of West Virginia any milk or milk product as defined in this regulation. Application(s) for such permit(s) shall be made to the appropriate Department of Health on a form prescribed and furnished by the State Department of Health.

Food service establishments, vending machines and similar establishments including grocery stores where milk or milk products are served or sold at retail, but not processed, are exempt from this requirement unless they are
