Subject: Schedule of Charges for Inspection Services: Fruit

Section 1 - GENERAL.

1.01 Scope. These regulations establish charges for Federal-State Inspection Service for Fruit.

1.02 Authority. These regulations are issued under authority of Chapter 19, Article 2 of the Official Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended.

1.03 Effective Date. These regulations are promulgated and become effective on \_\_\_\_\_.

1.04 Filing Date. These regulations were filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2 - DECLARATION OF POLICY.

2.01 Charges for Inspection Services. Chapter 19, Article 2, Section 5 of the Official Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, provides that the Commissioner of Agriculture may, upon request, render inspection service and issue Federal-State Inspection Certificates certifying the quality and/or condition of fruits produced, sold, traded, exchanged, transported or otherwise moved in the trade channels of West Virginia.

For the purpose of defraying the cost of inspection, the following schedule of charges shall prevail:

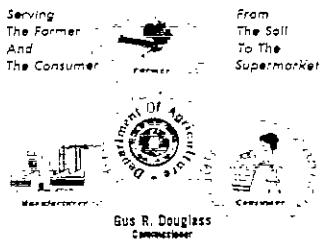

EXPENSES: All necessary expenses and 22¢ per mile.

SPECIAL WORK: Fees for singular size container or special work will be assessed on the basis of the above schedule as closely as practical.

be assessed on the basis of the above schedule as closely as  
practical.
