

# Proclamation

## by Governor Patrick Morrisey

- Whereas,** reinforced concrete pipe and precast concrete products are of critical importance to sustainable communities and to the health, safety, and well-being of the people of West Virginia; and
- Whereas,** such reinforced concrete pipe and precast concrete products and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of the concrete pipe and precast concrete industry, the trucking industry, the sand and rock producers, and the cement producers and employees; and
- Whereas,** these suppliers are responsible for designing, manufacturing, distributing, educating, and supplying reinforced concrete pipe and precast concrete products, made from rock, sand, water, and cement sourced from West Virginia; and
- Whereas,** West Virginia's own contractors are responsible for designing, constructing, and maintaining our transportation and storm drainage infrastructure and our residential and commercial subdivisions, which are essential to the State's security and sustainability; and
- Whereas,** it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders, and children of West Virginia to understand and appreciate the importance of reinforced concrete pipe and precast concrete in their respective communities.

**Now, Therefore,** Be it Resolved that I, Patrick Morrisey, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *September 21-27, 2025* as:

### *National Concrete Pipe Week*

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in this observance.


**In Witness Whereof,** I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
