Whereas, the citizens of West Virginia celebrate and wish for many more years of continued prosperity.



in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in observance.


In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
