Whereas, qualified professionals who specialize in the use of diagnostic medical ultrasound to aid physicians in the diagnosis of disease share a commitment to provide quality health care; and

Whereas, professionals in sonography are dedicated to the highest standards of professionalism and maintain these standards through continuing education, credentialing, and personal commitment; and

Whereas, the first week in October has been designated as *Nuclear Medicine Week* to focus on the use of medical ultrasound examinations provided through the skilled and conscientious efforts of diagnostic medical sonographers in West Virginia.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that I, Patrick Morrisey, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *October 6-12, 2025* as:

Nuclear Medicine Week

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in observance.
