A PROCLAMATION

By the Governor

WHEREAS, Don C. Perdue was born in Kenova, West Virginia on November 12, 1949;
and

WHEREAS, Don C. Perdue earned bachelors of science degrees in chemistry from
Marshall University and in pharmacy from Ohio Northern University; and

WHEREAS, Don C. Perdue was a pharmacist and the executive director of the Wayne
County Economic Development Authority; and

WHEREAS, Don C. Perdue served Wayne County in the West Virginia House of
Delegates from 1999 to 2016, representing at times the Seventeenth, Eighteenth, and Nineteenth
Delegate Districts, and serving as the chairman of the House Health Committee; and

WHEREAS, Don C. Perdue passed away on October 18, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of West Virginia, friends, and associates of Don C.
Perdue desire to recognize his dedicated public service to the Great State of West Virginia, and to
acknowledge his valuable contributions to the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK MORRISEY, by virtue of the authority vested in
me as the Governor of the State of West Virginia, do hereby **ORDER** that, in commemoration of
the distinguished life and service of Don C. Perdue, the United States and West Virginia State
flags displayed at the Capitol Complex in Charleston, West Virginia, and at all State facilities in
Wayne County, shall be lowered to half-staff beginning at noon on October 20, 2025, and to remain
there until sunset on the day of internment.
